Dance Guidelines

1. St. Rocco School administration, faculty and designees will be the sole chaperones at all middle school dances at the school.
2. All students must be dressed appropriately and modestly. No tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, miniskirts, low fitting pants, baseball caps, or clothing with any message, logo, picture or slogan that conflicts with Catholic values.
3. Inappropriate, suggestive or aggressive dancing is not permitted at any time. After a first warning, a second correction may result in a student being dismissed.
4. Cell phones at St. Rocco School are to be left in a designated basket upon entering the dance. Other electronic devices are not allowed at the dances and cannot be held at the door.
5. Backpacks and sports bags are not allowed at a St. Rocco School dance.
6. All St. Rocco School students attending a dance at St Rocco School must remain the entire time, unless a sickness ensues or another arrangement has been made prior to the dance with student's parent/guardian and the principal/designee.
7. Only St. Rocco School students are permitted to attend the dance. All other students, friends, family are prohibited from attending the dance.
8. All students will abide by the rules, policies and practices of St. Rocco School. Failure to comply with the school rules will result in dismissal from the dance and may result in further disciplinary action.
