Internet Safety ~ Many times, in all of our busy schedules, we need to remind our families about certain safety guidelines. Please take some time with your family in the next week to review the following Internet and Fire Safety Tips.

Here are a few common sense tips in order for you to keep your children safe online:

- The best safeguard against online dangers is being informed. A good place to start with some basics is www.LearntheNet.com.
- Discuss with your children about the benefits and dangers of the Internet. Explore their online interests. Ask your children who they are talking to online and what they are talking about. Provide guidelines for using the Internet. Write them down and review and post them near the computer.
- Remind them never to share personal information and have them tell you about anything that makes them feel uncomfortable.
- Make sure there is software on your computer that can block inappropriate websites, restrict the amount of time that your children are on the Internet and have a check regarding their Instant Messenger.
- Always know what your child is doing online by having open communication and conversation in order to reap the wonderful benefits of the Internet safely!

#### Fire Safety Tips ~



- Complete a home fire safety checklist and identify fire risks in your home.
- Test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors monthly and change the batteries at least one a year.
- Place smoke alarms on each floor of your home and in each bedroom.
- Make sure everyone in the house understands the family fire escape plan.



- Place fire extinguishers throughout your home and make sure everyone in the house knows how to use them.
- Never leave food unattended on the stove, keep all matches and lighters out of the reach of children, and don't place portable heaters near flammable materials.
- Know the telephone number for your local fire department.

Nurses News ... The Flu Clinic will be held on Thursday, October 18, 2017 from 9:00am~11:00am in Café Rocco for students in GRADE PK4 ~ 8.



No PreK 3 students will be able to receive the flu vaccine at school; student must see your own physician. Only PreK 4 students who have received a previous flu shot in their physician's office may get vaccinated at school. Any questions, feel free to call the School Nurse.

You do not need to print the form or parents can complete a paper consent form that is included in this packet and return it to school. All forms are due by October 6th. Please make sure when returning the form you fill it out completely.

<u>Hearing Screening</u> ~ The Town of Johnston Nurse will be here on October 26<sup>th</sup> to check the students in Grades K-3 for their hearing.

I would like to remind parents to have your children eat breakfast before school. We've had several instances recently, with children complaining of stomach aches and headaches when they arrive at school. Further



questioning reveals that they have not eaten anything for breakfast. I know that mornings are very hectic with getting children ready for school and getting ready for work. There are several portable versions of breakfast that could work in these situations. Some examples are: Granola bars, toaster waffles, cheese sticks, yogurt, fruit, applesauce, juice boxes. If they can't eat at home, they can eat in the car. Another alternative is <a href="Early Morning">Early Morning</a> Breakfast at school at 7:45 am, for a charge of \$2.00. Children need to fuel their brains in order for them to function at their best.
