## **INCOMING FIRST GRADE**

#### Dear Parents,

The following list offers book suggestions for parents to read to their children. They are excellent sources of literature for your child to enjoy listening to as well as from which your child can learn reading skills at the same time. As you read a book, bring the following skills to the attention of your child:

- known sight words, letters/sounds,
- rhyming words, repetition of words, new vocabulary,
- parts of speech, sentence structure,
- story details, character traits/ character feelings,
- predict what will happen next in the story, recognize cause/effect,
- distinguish fact/fantasy, sequence events in a story


