



Eligibility/Criteria Requirements



Eligibility Requirements

Students in grades 5–7 who meet the following criteria outlined in the guidelines listed below set forth by St. Rocco School will be eligible to run for office or be considered for a special appointment.

1. HAVE A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 70 OR BETTER IN ALL CLASSES.
2. STUDENT COUNCIL MEMBERS NEEDS TO BE RESOURCEFUL, GOOD PROBLEM SOLVERS, ENTHUSIASTIC PROMOTERS OF SCHOOL ACTIVITIES, DEPENDABLE, AND ABLE TO ATTEND WEEKLY OR BI-WEEKLY MORNING MEETINGS.
3. STUDENT COUNCIL MEMBERS REPRESENT ST. ROCCO SCHOOL EVERYDAY AND IN EVERY ACTIVITY.
4. MEMBERS SHOULD DEMONSTRATE HIGH STANDARDS OF HONESTY, RELIABILITY, COURTESY, AND RESPECT FOR OTHERS.
5. ALL MEMBERS OF STUDENT COUNCIL WILL BE EVALUATED AT ANY POINT DURING THE TRIMESTER AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO INELIGIBILITY TO PERFORM THEIR ROLES.

Students who meet the criteria and wish to run for office must complete the nomination form posted online. The form must be signed by both student /parent and returned to school.
